A slower walk through what it actually feels like to have a website made for you — what it costs, who holds the keys, and how we make sure it's right before anyone else ever sees it.

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01 A quieter place to *begin*

You know your business could use a real website. You've probably also felt the knot that comes with it — the sense that every option is either a weekend-eating project, a bill with a comma in it, or a stranger you're supposed to just trust.

So let's slow down. There's no form to fill out here and nothing to decide. This is just a calm walk through how it actually works, what it costs, and how we make sure it's right — so that if you do move forward, it feels like a small step, not a leap.

02 Is a website even *worth* it?

Social profiles are rented land — helpful, but you don't control them, and they're gone the day the platform changes its mind. A website is the one place online that's genuinely yours: your home base, where people find you, trust you, and book you.

It works while you're with a customer, asleep, or off the clock — quietly answering questions and sending you the right kind of leads. For most small businesses, that's the difference between being found and being guessed at.

03 What your website actually *needs*

Most owners imagine a website is a giant, complicated thing. It usually needs less than you fear — and what it does need, made well, does more than a bloated one ever could.

- A clear first impression that says who you are and who you help
- The handful of things people came to find — services, prices, hours, how to reach you
- One obvious next step, so a visitor becomes a booking or a call
- Speed and findability, so Google and your customers both take you seriously

04 Made, not *templated*

Every site is hand-coded from the ground up, for your business — shaped around your services and your customers rather than poured into a one-size layout. That means it's fast, easy for Google to read, and built to reflect you.

And because one person writes every line, there's one person who understands it end to end — the same person who'll look after it once it's live.

05 The Revision *approach*

The whole build is collaborative and visible — there's no big reveal you're handed at the end and stuck with. You see it take shape and steer the whole way.

01 First look

An early preview of your site. You go through it and tell me what feels right and what you'd change.

02 Second look

I fold in your notes and send a fresh version. We shape the details together.

03 Last glance

The final pass. When it feels like yours, you give the word.

04 You approve — then it launches

Your approval is what takes the site live. Until then, still nothing is public.

06 Nothing goes live until *you* say so

This is the part worth slowing down for. You see the design before anyone else does, and it only goes public when you approve it. If it isn't right, we keep refining — no new charges, no pressure.

The thing people quietly fear most — paying for something and being stuck with a version they don't love — simply isn't on the table.

07 It's *yours* to keep

Ever worry that leaving a web company means losing your whole site? That doesn't happen here. You get the actual files — the real code, your domain, a site you can walk away with.

No long-term contract.

Cancel any time.

Keep your files.

I keep it cancel-anytime on purpose — I'd rather earn your renewal each month than trap you into it. You don't need to be technical to own your site; it just means you're never stuck with me.

08 Investment and *fit*

A custom site from an agency often runs \$5,000 to \$15,000. Here's the whole number, up front — one-time to build, then a flat monthly care plan. No surprises, no quiet add-ons.

from \$350 once

The build — designing, customizing, and launching your site. Priced per design; yours to keep.

from \$35/mo

Site Care — everything that keeps it live and looked after. About a dollar a day.

What that monthly covers — the things you'd otherwise pay for one by one:

Website hosting	included
Your domain name	included
SSL security certificate	included
Monthly edits, made for you	included
A developer on call for changes	included
Your monthly care	from \$35

09 After it's *live*

Launch isn't the end of the relationship — it's the calm part. Need a change? You ask, and I make it. No dashboards to wrestle, no code to touch.

Your monthly edits

Real changes, included every month and refreshed each cycle — swap a photo, update your hours, add a seasonal note. Most months only use a few.

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WHEN YOU'RE READY

Start by finding a design you *love*.

Explore the collection and pick the design that fits your business. When one feels right, you check out — and your client portal is created right then. From there we shape your site together through the preview rounds, and nothing goes live until you approve it.
